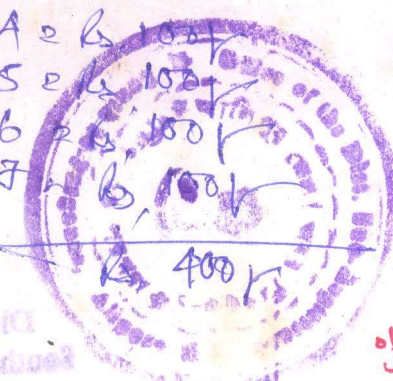

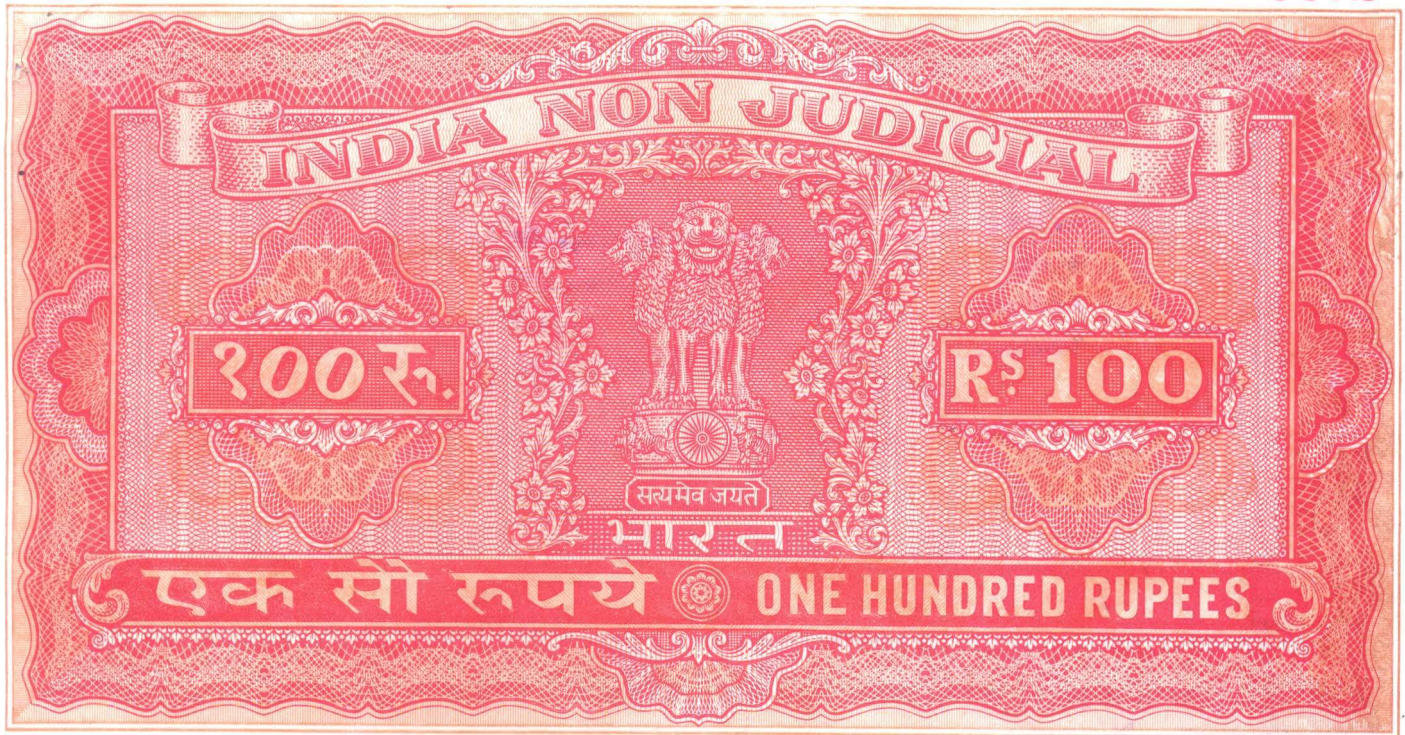

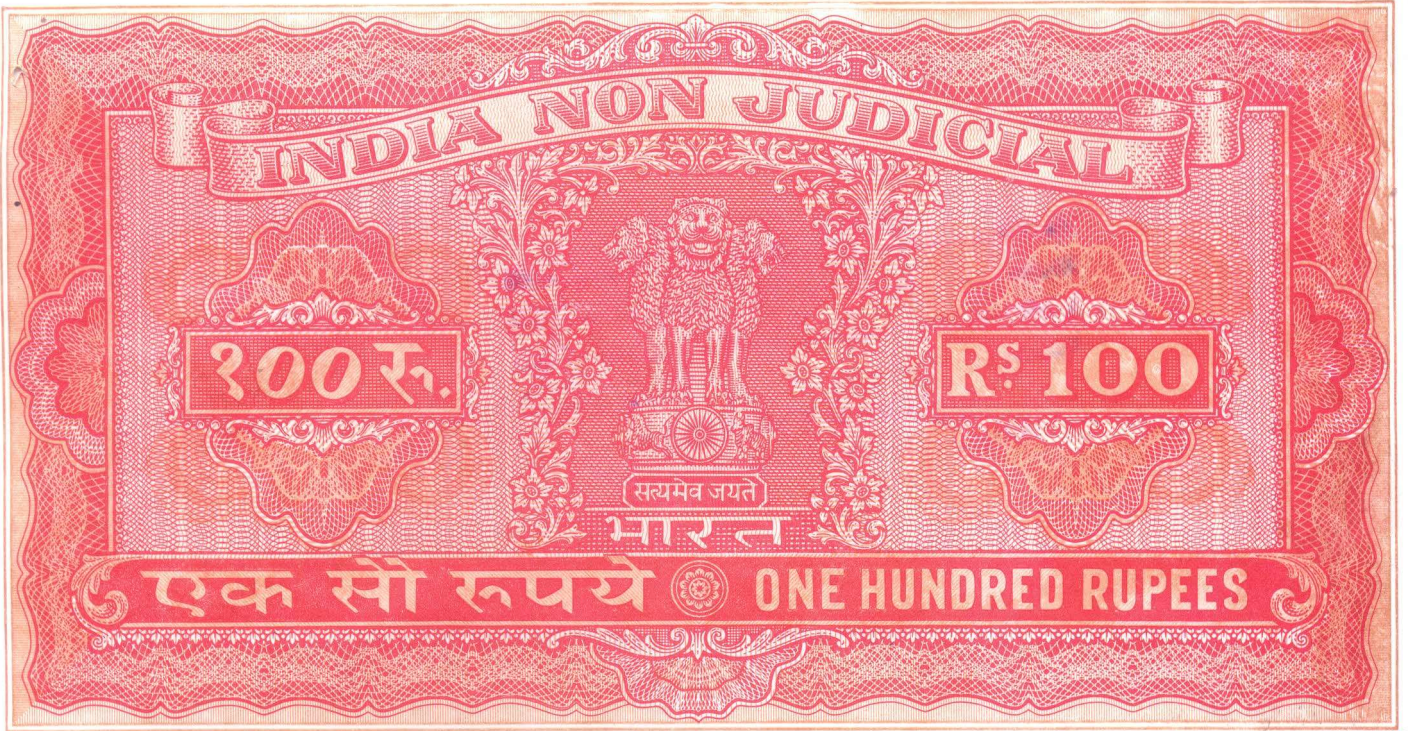

4. AND WHEREAS the said Academy has also established a musical institution.

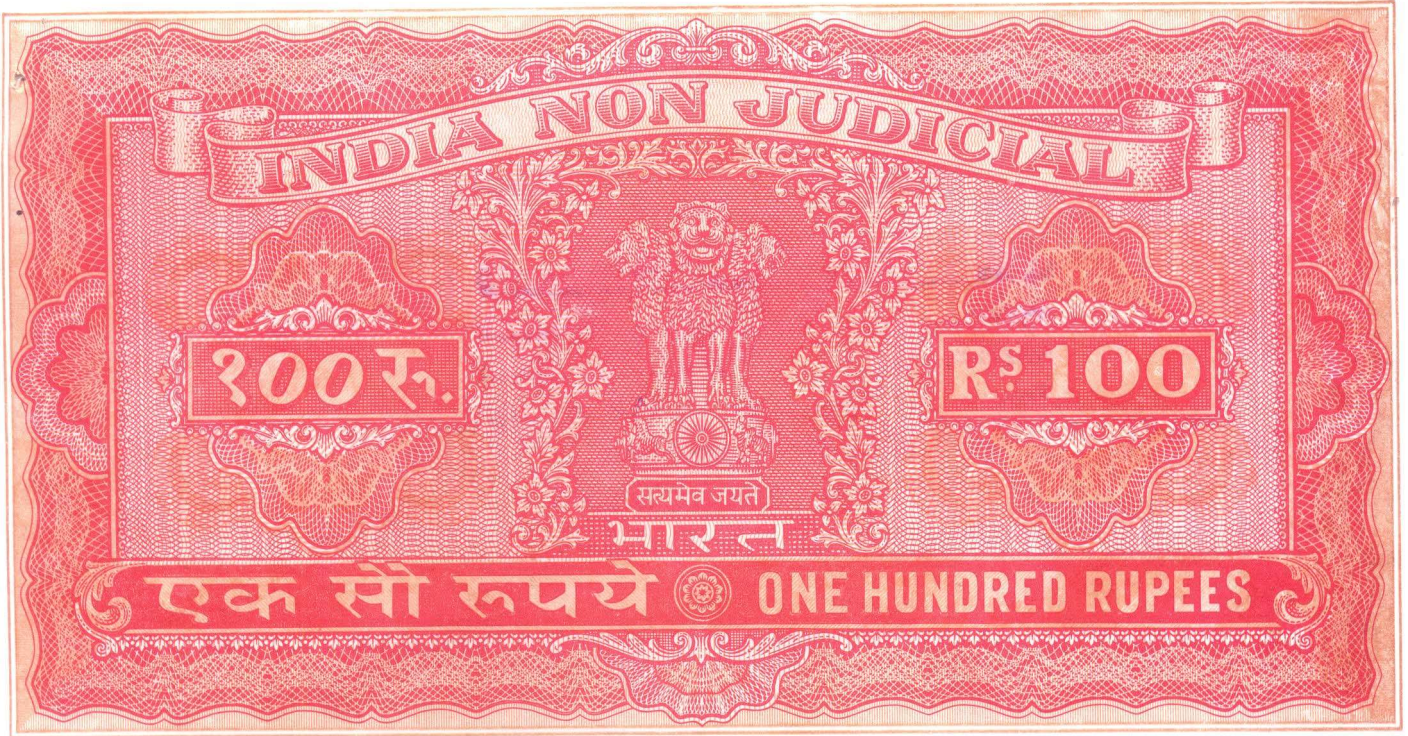

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6. AND WHEREAS the Settlor is desirous of creating a trust for public charitable purposes in India and in particular for establishing, running and/or managing schools, colleges and other educational or cultural institutions for fostering education and/or diffusion of useful knowledge or attainment of such objects and for that purpose, the Settler has made over to the Trustees under this Deed, a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) as initial contribution to the said Trust.

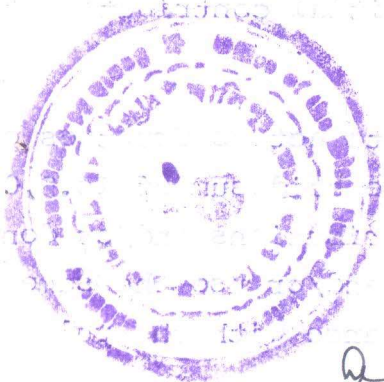

Properties" ) upon trust and to apply the same including the corpus and income thereof for the objects and purposes hereinafter expressed with the powers and on the terms and conditions hereinafter expressed concerning the same.

2. The name of the Trust shall be "Nava Nalanda Educational and Cultural Trust".

3. The objects and purposes of the Trust are :-

- (a) To take over ownership, control and management of the High School at present situated at No. 25, Southern Avenue, Calcutta - 700 029 under the name of Nava Nalanda High School and any other Higher Secondary, High and/or Primary School, and to run and manage and operate them on such terms and conditions and in such manner so as not to ensure benefits to any of the persons referred to in Section 13 of the Income-Tax Act, 1961.
- (b) To establish, support, maintain and/or grant aid to school, colleges, technical and/or other institutions, libraries, reading rooms, lecture halls, study groups, public museums, works of art or collection of natural history and to grant aid for the promotion of science or literature or fine arts of diffusion of useful knowledge or economical and scientific inventions and designs and to grant aid, support and maintain persons and/or institutions engaged therein.
- (c) To aid, establish, run and maintain hospitals, dispensaries, nursing homes, clinics, sanatoria and other institutions and bodies for rendering medical aid and relief.
- (d) To feed the poor and establish, maintain and support and/or grant aid to orphanages and alms houses and/or to give aid in cash or kind to widows or indigent people.

2. The name of the Trust shall be "Nava Vidya Educational and  
Social Trust".

3. The objects and purposes of the Trust are :-

(a) To take over ownership, control and management of the  
School of Arts and Sciences at No. 25, South Main Road,  
Chennai - 600 022 and to run and operate the same as a  
school for any other higher secondary, high and/or technical school,  
and to run and operate and operate them on such terms and  
conditions and in such manner as to not to incur liability  
to any of the persons referred to in section 13 of the  
Income-Tax Act, 1961.

(b) To establish, support, maintain and/or assist in the  
establishment of any or other institutions, colleges, technical  
schools, libraries, study groups, research centres, and  
works of art or collection of natural history or scientific  
works for the promotion of science or technical education  
or education of useful knowledge or to assist in the  
investigation and research and to assist in the  
establishment of or institutions engaged therein.



(c) To acquire, purchase, lease, and maintain hospitals, dispensaries,  
nursing homes, clinics, sanatoria, and institutions for  
the benefit of the poor and distressed.

(d) To do all such other things as may be necessary or proper  
to carry out the objects and purposes of the Trust and to  
do all such things as may be necessary or proper to carry out  
the objects and purposes of the Trust.

- (e) To establish, support and maintain and/or to grant aid to institutions for upliftment of backward and depressed classes irrespective of caste, creed and religion.
- (f) To establish and/or grant aid to boarding houses and hostels for students and to grant scholarships, stipends, give prizes and other help to students.
- (g) To grant relief on the occasion of earthquake and floods and other occasions of calamities and public suffering and to give donation and/or aid to other institutions or persons doing such relief works.
- (h) To promote physical culture and education and to assist and promote sports and games and generally to do all acts for the improvement of general health and physical development.
- (i) To provide for medical relief, relief for the poor, educations and advancement of any other object of general public utility.
- (j) To promote, organize and administer and/or establish, support and maintain and/or grant aid to any person, institutions or fund whatsoever having for its objects charitable purposes which tend to promote social welfare.

4. The Trust hereby created is irrevocable and the Settler will have no power to revoke the Trust.

5. The funds of the Trust will be utilized in India for public charitable purposes.

6. The investments of the funds of the Trust will be made in such manner as provided in Section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as

7. No part of the Trust properties or its income shall be applied for any purpose which is not a public charitable purpose in law save and except for the running of the Institution effectively.

8. The Trust shall not pay any remuneration to the Trustees except actual out-of-pocket expenses incurred by them for the purpose of discharging duties as Trustees of the Trust.

Provided, however, that if any of the Trustees is called upon to render specialised services to the Trust, which involves exploitation of his personal skill, knowledge or talent, then he may be paid reasonable amount or amounts, out of the funds of the Trust as his fees or remuneration, which would have been otherwise payable by the Trust for getting similar services.

9. The Trustees shall have the following powers :-

- (a) To invest the Trust properties or the income thereof not immediately required for the objects and purposes of the Trust in such form and mode as prescribed in Section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961, as may be amended from time to time.
- (b) To sell, alter, use, vary or transpose or otherwise dispose of the Trust properties or any investment representing the same and to reinvest the same in any manner as the Trustees may in their discretion think fit, subject to the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- (c) To open account in the name of the Trust with any nationalised Bank or Banks and to operate such account and to give necessary instructions to the Bank. Any of the two trustees shall be authorised by way of resolution by the Trustees to sign instrument/cheques and/or any other documents whether statutory or otherwise.
- (d) To pay all charges, impositions and other outgoings payable in respect of the Trust properties or any property comprised in the Trust and also to pay all expenses incurred in the management of the Trust.

In part of the trust properties or its income shall be applied for any other purpose which is not a public charitable purpose as defined in section 11 of the Income Tax Act, 1922.

The Trust shall not pay any remuneration to the Trustees except for the expenses incurred by them for the purpose of discharging their duties as Trustees of the Trust.

Provided, however, that if any of the Trustees is called upon to perform any special services to the Trust, which requires the use of his personal skill, knowledge or talent, then he shall be entitled to receive a special remuneration, out of the funds of the Trust as the Trustees may determine, which shall not be chargeable to the Trust for any special services.

The Trustees shall have the following powers :-

- (a) To invest the trust properties or the income thereof in any manner as may be approved for the objects and purposes of the Trust in accordance with the provisions of section 11 of the Income Tax Act, 1922, and to vary the investments from time to time.
- (b) To sell, lease, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of any part of the trust properties or to acquire any part of the same and to reinvest the proceeds thereof in any manner as may be approved for the objects and purposes of the Trust.

In the event of any dispute between the Trustees or any other person claiming to be entitled to the trust properties or its income, the Trust shall be deemed to be a public charitable trust for the purposes of the Income Tax Act, 1922.

- (e) To enter into contracts and borrow moneys for the purposes of the Trust or for managing the Trust properties.
- (f) To let out or give lease any immovable property on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may think fit and proper.
- (g) To compromise, compound, refer to arbitration all actions, suits, proceedings and disputes touching upon the Trust properties or any of them.
- (h) To accept donation and/or contribution in cash or in kind from anyfor the objects and purposes of the trust on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may in their absolute discretion think fit and proper.
- (i) To part with the whole or any portion of the Trust properties for the benefit of any other Trust having public charitable objects similar to all or any of the objects of this Trust.
- (j) To appoint Managing Committee, Secretary, Manager, Treasurer, Clerks or other Officers or employees to look after and manage the Trust properties and to allot to such Secretary, Manager, Treasurer, Clerks or other Officers or employees such duties as the Trustees may think fit and proper.
- (k) To frame Rules and Regulations for carrying out and giving effect to the objects and purposes of the Trust and for that to substitute, modify, abrogate any of the said Rules and Regulations as may be found necessary by the Trustees from time to time, provided however, that the Rules and Regulations so made shall not violate the provisions of the Sections 11 to 13 such other relevant provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as may be enforced from time to time.
- (l) To amalgamate this Trust with any other Trust having similar objects or to get other Trust having similar objects amalgamated with this Trust with prior sanction of all the Trustees

- (a) To enter into contracts and borrow money for the purposes of the trust or for managing the trust property.
- (b) To let or give lease any immovable property owned by the trust or to take any lease or tenancy of any immovable property as the trustees may think fit and proper.
- (c) To compromise, compound, refer to arbitration or adjust, settle, execute and discharge all claims, demands, suits, proceedings and disputes touching upon the trust property or any of them.
- (d) To accept donation and/or contribution in cash or in kind for the objects and purposes of the trust on such conditions as the trustees may in their absolute discretion think fit and proper.
- (e) To grant any whole or any portion of the trust property for the benefit of any other trust having public charitable objects similar to all or any of the objects of this trust.



(f) To appoint managing Committee, Secretary, Clerk or other Officers or agents for the trust and to remove any of them and to give powers to any of them, to do all such acts and things as the trustees may think fit and proper.

(g) To make rules and regulations for the management and conduct of the affairs of the trust and to alter or amend any such rules and regulations from time to time.

(h) To do all such acts and things as the trustees may think fit and proper for the objects and purposes of the trust.

(i) To make any gift or grant of any part of the trust property for the objects and purposes of the trust.

10. The number of Trustees shall not be less than four and more than seven.
11. The Trustees shall not delegate their powers and authorities to their agents and/or any other person or persons claiming interest under the Trustees neither for the management and administration of the Trust property nor otherwise at any point of time or at all.
12. The Trustees may, however, delegate any of their powers to one or more Committees or Sub-Committees consisting of such person or persons from amongst themselves as they may think fit and such Committee or sub-Committee shall function subject to such rules or directions as may be prescribed or given for the purposes by the Trustees from time to time.
13. A Trustee will not be responsible for any act or default of his Co-Trustees or the agent(s), employee(s) or Constituted Attorney(s) appointed by him for any loss unless such loss is occasioned by his own wilful act or negligence or default.
14. Any of the Trustees may retire by giving one month's notice in writing to the other Trustees or Trustees.
15. If any Trustee dies or retires or becomes incapable or unfit to act, the continuing or the surviving Trustees shall be entitled to appoint a successor in the place and stead of the Trustees dying or retiring or becoming incapable or unfit to act. The Trustees may, by a majority of three-fourth, be at liberty to remove any of the Trustees for breach of Trust or misconduct and/or continued negligence of his duties towards the affairs of the Trust.
16. The existing Trustees may from time to time appoint one or more Trustees as additional Trustees at their discretion but in any case, the total number of Trustees including the new Trustees to be appointed shall not exceed seven.

17. Upon the appointment of a new Trustee, the Trust properties shall vest in the new Trustee jointly with the continuing or surviving Trustees.

18. The Trust shall maintain regular accounts of its receipts and expenditures. The first accounts of the Trust shall be closed on 31st March, 1999 and the accounts for the period thereafter shall be closed annually on 31st March every year.

19. The Trustees may from time to time rules for regulating the meeting of Trustees. In the absence of such regulations :-

- i) All matters will be decided by majority and three Trustees shall form a quorum for meeting of Trustees.
- ii) Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees and evidenced in writing under the hands of three-fourth of the Trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a resolution duly passed at a meeting of the Trustees.
